

**SOUTH HAVEN CHARTER TOWNSHIP
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
WEDNESDAY, JULY 12, 2017**

Meeting was called to order by Trustee DeGrandchamp at 7:30 p.m.

June 14, 2017 minutes were accepted as presented.

Residents from 76th Street were in attendance to ask the board to consider bike trails on the portions of 76th Street that are very narrow and dangerous for pedestrians. Gail Patterson, County Commissioner, was in attendance to present a report from the County. Officer Pauly of the SHPD was in attendance to give a report. Linda Meeks expressed concern over bike traffic on the trails. Many cyclists are not stopping for cross traffic when crossing roads on the trails.

It was reported that permits have been issued for the Evergreen Bluff project.

Trustee Wiatrowski reported that the Township Hall roof is still on scheduled to be replaced in August.

There was no new information on bids for refuse removal at the transfer station.

Craig Aranoff from Cannabis Legal Group was in attendance to give a presentation on the updated Michigan Marijuana Laws.

There was no new information on the creation of a Building Authority with the City of South Haven and the Library to oversee bonds for the library improvements.

Reports from various committees and authorities were received. Gail Patterson was in attendance for the Library.

Motion by Bertorelli, supported by Kiry, to approve the Budget Amendments as presented by the Clerk's office. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Fisher, supported by Bertorelli, to approve payment of anticipated bills in the amount of \$37,855.06. All voted in favor by roll call vote. Motion carried.
